Re: Disneyland and Paris Trip 2012

We are delighted to offer your child the opportunity to travel with us on a three night, four day trip to Disneyland and Paris. This is the 11th year we have run this very successful trip. The trip, which is being offered to current Year 7, 8, 9 & 10 pupils will take place during the October half term break; departing on Friday 26th October and returning to school on Tuesday 30th October 2012.

The trip includes:

- A Bateaux Mouches Boat trip
- A visit to a Chocolate Factory
- A visit to the Stade de France
- A visit to Cité des Sciences
- Two days in Disneyland Paris from 10.00 am - all rides are free
- Return journey home via coach and channel tunnel crossing
- 3* Hotel Situated on the Outskirts of Paris
- Full Insurance Cover
- Hoodie (designed by the pupils)

The cost of this extremely popular trip is approximately £360 per pupil, with places being offered on a first come, first served basis. School reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone who displays unacceptable behaviour in school. If you would like to reserve a place for your child, then please return the enclosed permission slip with a non-refundable deposit of £50, to be paid by Friday the 27th January 2012, a further payment of £50 to be paid by Friday 24th February 2012 and then a further five monthly payments of £52 to be paid by Friday the 20th July 2012; or you could pay smaller amounts each week using a payment card. If paying by cheque, then please make this payable to 'Earlsheaton Technology College Trip Fund'.

Pupils who go on this trip will need to have their own passport and a current European Health Card (E111). Details of these requirements will follow nearer the time.

Details of meetings to discuss the trip will also follow in due course.

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Please note that all deposits are paid directly to the travel company so should your child later decide that they no longer wish to participate in the trip, then any money paid is non-refundable, unless we are able to find a pupil to take their place. Should your child decide less than 10 weeks before departure that they no longer want to participate in the trip, then the full amount may be lost. Your child may also be removed from the trip if they display negative behaviour and once again any money paid will only be paid back if a replacement can be found, unless this occurred less than 10 weeks before departure when the full amount would be lost.
